

**BYLAWS
OF THE
TRI-REGION CHAPTER
OF THE
TEXAS ASSOCIATION OF APPRAISAL DISTRICTS**

Article I

The name of this organization shall be Tri-Region CHAPTER OF THE TEXAS ASSOCIATION OF APPRAISAL DISTRICTS. Chapter jurisdiction shall be throughout Regions 3, 6, and 13 of the Texas Association of Appraisal Districts.

Article II

The purpose of this Chapter shall be the advancement of the objectives of the Texas Association of Appraisal Districts within the Chapter's area.

Article III

Membership in this Chapter shall be open to members in good standing of the Texas Association of Appraisal Districts and to those individuals who are affiliated with the Texas Property Tax System.

The governing body of this Chapter shall be the Executive Board, which shall be composed of the current President of the Chapter, Vice-President, Secretary-Treasurer, AND the immediate Past President of the Chapter, to be elected BI-ANNUALLY by the general vote of the Chapter members.

Article IV

The officers of this Chapter shall be the President, Vice-President, and Secretary-Treasurer. All officers shall be elected at the regular meeting of the Chapter during the month of October in odd years, and shall assume their offices when sworn in at the following regular March meeting of the Chapter.

Article V

Nominations for all officers shall be both from the report of the Nominations Committee and from the floor of the regular Chapter meeting in September of odd years. Election shall be by majority vote of the Chapter members in actual attendance at said meeting. All officers shall serve until their successors qualify. Any vacancy on the Executive Board or slate of officers shall be filled by special elections conducted in like manner to the bi-annual election but at the first available regular Chapter meeting.

Article VI

The President may cause to be organized and appoint members to serve on the Nominations Committee and such other committees as may be deemed appropriate. The Nominations Committee shall be composed of at least three Chapter members. All Committee members shall serve at the pleasure of the President. The President shall serve as an Ex-officio, non-voting member on all committees except the nominations committee.

Article VII

Regular called meetings of the Chapter shall be held on the second Thursday of the months of March and October. Special called meetings may be called by the President or any two members of the Executive Board.

The time and place of the Chapter meetings shall be announced at the preceding Chapter meeting or in the official newsletter of the Chapter.

Executive Board meetings shall be held immediately preceding each regular Chapter meeting in March and October. Special called meetings of the Executive Board may be called by the President or any two members of the Executive Board.

Article VIII

Amendment of the bylaws of this Chapter shall be by majority vote of the Chapter members present and voting at any regular or called meeting of the Chapter.

Article IX

All members of this Chapter shall be voting members. All members of this chapter shall be eligible to serve as officers.

Article X

Operating fees of this Chapter shall be \$5.00 per person, per meeting.

Article XI

Membership in this Chapter shall be terminated by written resignation addressed to the President or Executive Board, or by any member district's termination of status as a member in good standing of the Texas Association of Appraisal Districts.

Article XII

All dues and other monies of the Chapter shall be the responsibility of the Secretary-Treasurer of the Chapter, who shall safeguard the same, and make report thereof at every regular called Chapter meeting. All funds of the Chapter shall be maintained in a Chapter banking account and drafts in said account shall require the signature of either the President or Secretary-Treasurer.
